Materials Needed

- Baby Wipes
- Rubber Bands
- Washable Markers
- Paper Towels





Instructions



Step One: Pinch the center of a baby wipe in your hand.



Step Three: Have your child use a marker to color each section of the baby wipe. *Hint: The more the marker gets into the folds, the more vibrant the color will be.*



Step Two: Twist into a roll and carefully attach a few rubber bands.



Step Four: Remove the rubber bands and gently unfold the baby wipe. Lay on top of a paper towel to dry.
